Job Title: Staff Counselor, Counseling Service

Position Reports to: Director of Counseling Services

Position Summary: Support the Counseling Center mission to provide both services and training to students and support the mission of the Division of Student Affairs, specifically by providing services to the Chatham community through the Counseling Center

Qualifications:

Licensed Professional Psychologist in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Doctoral degree in Counseling Psychology/Clinical Psychology Minimum of three years' experience of counseling and administrative work in higher education

(may include postoctoral work)

- Psychological Assessments and Evaluations
- Psychological and Brief therapeutic treatments
- Crisis Intervention/referrals
- Management and supervision of graduate counseling internship program
- Office Management skills

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Adhere to and train practicum trainees to adhere to Counseling Center policies and procedures
- Provide consultation, education, and outreach services to faculty, staff, and students on developmental, mental health and wellness, and harm-reduction issues
- Participate in Counseling Services emergency and crisis response procedures, including an "on call" rotation, with full-time staff counselors in a regular rotation and part-time staff taking "on call" if other Counseling Services staff are out of the office
- Assist in the development, implementation, and maintenance of an annual 1st year practicum experience for Chatham PsyD students
- Assist in the implementation and maintenance of an annual practicum experience for advanced students from Chatham and other university/college counseling, psychology and social work programs
- Provide counseling services (individual therapy and group/support counseling) to students, via both in-person and telehealth modalities
- Provide career counseling and referrals to students when it is appropriate in the course of therapy and/or when Career Development is unable to provide career exploration and career counseling. Training will be provided if needed.
- Provide assessment and psychological evaluations for students, including psychodiagnostics evaluation when clinically appropriate
- Provide students with appropriate referrals when needed
- Consult with mental health professionals (physicians/psychiatrists/other providers) regarding students' needs for referrals and/or to providing appropriate care or continuity of care, including medication
- Liaise with members of the University community to encourage referrals to the Counseling Service when students need support

- Identify and engage in practices that encourage adaptable, flexible, problem-solving approaches among staff and trainees
